**Guiding Principles:**

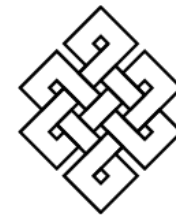
- Access to quality childcare, especially for infants and toddlers

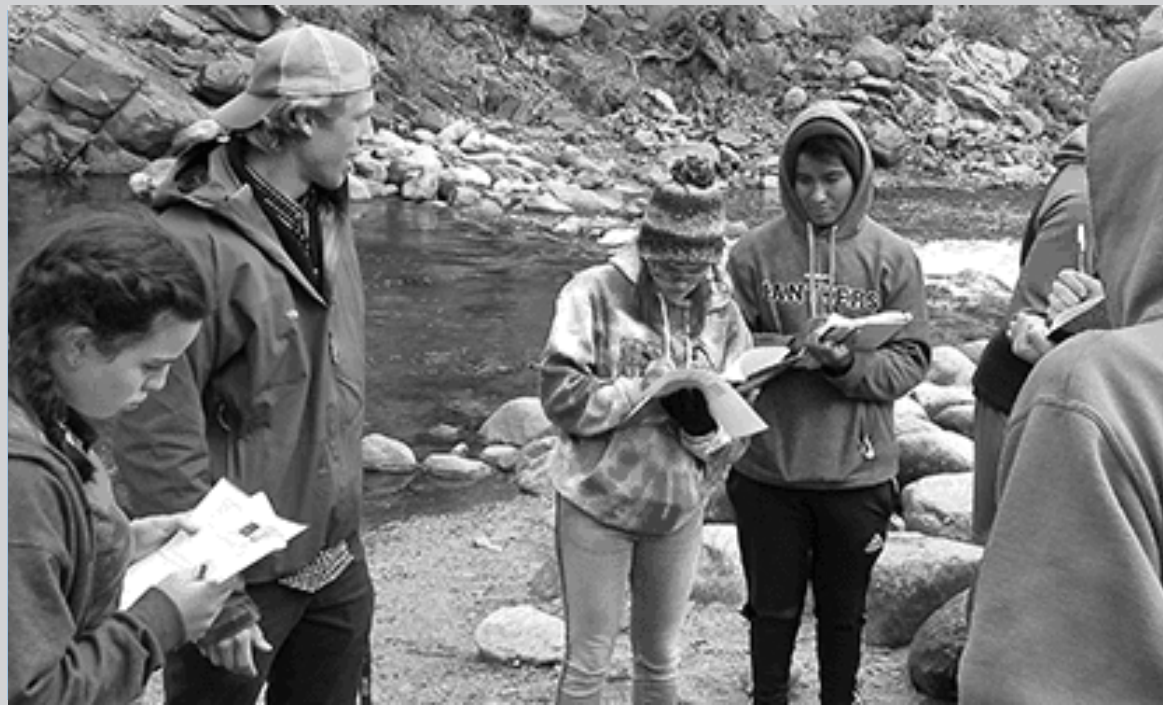

Founded in 2007 by Natalie and Bobby Lewis, The Link School is life-preparation focused and offers students of, and those interested in, Christian Science an experiential high school program.

The Link School emphasizes education in an environment that cultivates curiosity, self-directed learning, collaboration, resourcefulness, and problem solving. MENTOR engages with the private, public, and nonprofit sectors to ensure that all youth have the support they need through mentoring relationships to succeed at home, school and, ultimately, work.

By becoming a dependable resource to members of the Navajo Nation and Zuni Pueblo, RezDawg Rescue collaborates with several rescues in NM, AZ and CO to ensure the safe and comfortable transport of unwanted animals to rescues, shelters and fosters where they will have a chance at a forever home.

**Guiding Principles:**

- Transportation to foster homes and other partner organizations
- Medical care and low/no cost spay and neuter services
- Teaching people how to humanely care for their animals
- Responding to cases of animal cruelty and neglect
- Emergency veterinary care for animals that are suffering on a case-by-case basis
- Network of foster homes for temporary shelter
- Adoption events so that these animals can find forever homes

Community outreach is accomplished by going door-to-door and developing long standing relationships with native communities based on trust and mutual respect. In 2019, 1,754 dogs and cats were rescued and 1,194 found their forever homes.
